



LISTENING - 2

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Course Description

This course is the second level of the listening series. To take this course, students are supposed to **have finished** Listening – 1. This is because Listening – 2 demands the competency that should have been achieved by finishing Listening – 1 course. That is to say, **students will potentially have problems to take Listening-2 before they finish Listening-1.**



Objectives

Upon the completion of this course, students should be able to **understand spoken directions or instructions**, **spoken past events** and **explanation on how something works or takes place**.



Basic Competencies to Achieve

- to understand spoken **instructions** or **directions**
- to understand spoken **personal story**
- to understand spoken **news items**
- to understand spoken explanation on **how something is produced**
- to understand spoken explanation on **how something works**
- to understand spoken explanation on **how a natural phenomenon takes place**
- to understand spoken explanation on how a **social phenomenon takes place**



Assessment

- **Competency Test-1:** To check students' competency in understanding spoken **instructions or directions**. (25%)
- **Competency Test-2:** To check students' competency in understanding **personal story and news items** (25%)
- **Competency Test-3:** To check students' competency in understanding spoken **explanation on how something is produced and how something works** (25%)
- **Competency Test-4:** To check students' competency in understanding spoken **explanation on a social and natural phenomena** (25%)

Assignments submitted prior to each competency test will also contribute to the final mark
