Language: Definition (1)

Language is a purely **human** and **non-instinctive** method of communicating ideas, emotions, and desires by means of **voluntarily produced symbols** (Sapir, 1921)

Why Human Language is Unique

Human Language	Animal Language
No relationship between sound and meaning, many possible combinations.	Sound directly related to meaning.
Use of grammar to create complex structures.	Lacking grammatical structure.

Language: Definition (2)

A language is a system of arbitrary vocal symbols by means of which a social group **co-operates** (Bloch & Trager, 1942)

Language: Definition (3)

 Language is the institution whereby humans communicate and interact with each other by means of habitually used oral-auditory arbitrary symbols (Hall, 1968)

Language: Definition (4)

Language is a **set** (finite or infinite) of **sentences**, each **finite in length** and **constructed out of a finite set of elements** (Chomsky, 1957).

Language: Definition (5)

Language is a **system** of **arbitrary vocal symbols** used by members of a society to **cooperate**, **communicate**, and to show **self-identity** (Kridalaksana, 2005)
